Scholarship Background: The Frances West Scholarship honors a founding member of the NCCRWC who has worked to empower women & support candidates including Pete DuPont, Mike Castle and many of the new generation of women in Delaware's Republican party. She has had numerous positions in the Delaware Federation of Republican Women, including a key role in developing leadership in the unit clubs. She was the first woman to have a statewide cabinet position and has been inducted into the Delaware Women's Hall of Fame. The NCCRWC's mission is to provide an avenue for women to influence policy, develop and support candidates, provide leadership opportunities, and to positively impact the political environment in our state and county. - Applicant must be applying for or accepted into post high school educational opportunities
- Applicant must be a female who can provide proof of residency in New Castle County.
- Proof of status as student enrolled in accredited undergraduate or professional / vocational program.
- Completed application form with all required attachments

Parent Signature (if applicant is under 18 years):

- Copy of high school or post-secondary transcript with certified GPA of at least 2.5 and documentation of the highest GPA possible
- Priority is given to young women who are registered Republicans
- Completed application postmarked by March 25th, 2025 and mailed to address in heading or emailed before midnight on Saturday, March 29th to <u>beardkah@hotmail.com</u>

<u>Agreement:</u> The application and supporting information becomes the property of the New Castle County Republican Women's Club, Inc. The scholarship recipient is required to attend a spring or summer NCCRWC meeting at which time the scholarship will be officially awarded. Club meeting time/location will be provided to the recipient.
